Matrix Meter & Spot Meter Technique

Set your Control Dial to "P" (Program Mode). You can also use the "A" (Aperture Mode) or "S" (Shutter Speed Mode).

Set your ISO to 400; this is a good base-line or starting ISO.

If there is less sun light, such as indoors or in a darker room, then use a higher ISO, 800, 1600.

Choose any Lens Focal Length between 18 mm and 200 mm.

Take 1 photo of the subject with the light meter on Matrix.

Take 3 photos of the subject with the light meter on Spot in the following way:

- Place the Spot Meter directly on the subject.
- Place the Spot Meter to the left or right of the subject.
- Place the Spot Meter half-way on subject on either the left or right side of the subject.

Lens Focal Length	Set Light Meter To	Place Light Meter On
Anywhere between 18 mm & 200 mm	Matrix	Center of Subject
Anywhere between 18 mm & 200 mm	Spot	Directly on Subject
Anywhere between 18 mm & 200 mm	Spot	Left or Right of Subject
Anywhere between 18 mm & 200 mm	Spot	Half-way on Subject on either Left or Right Side
